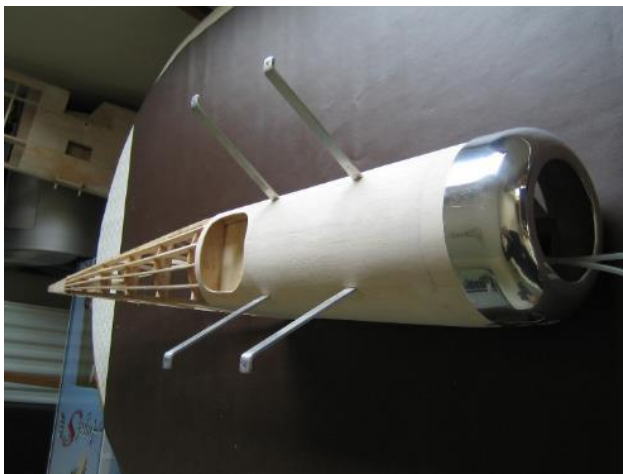
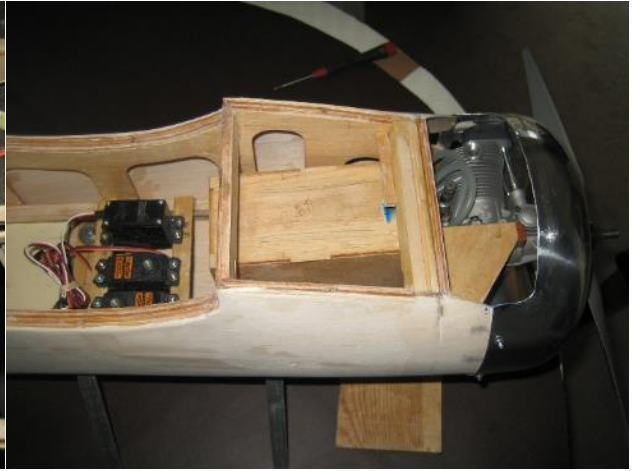
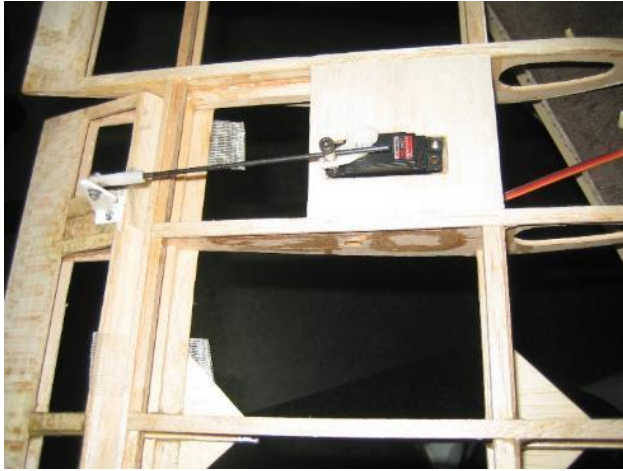




Mike, Krys and Colin putting our new table/stand into use, kindly constructed by Chairman Mat and Colin.
