<u>Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> May – BMFA 100 Nationwide World Record Attempt.</u> Despite some rain we had a large complement of pilots and spectators for our participation as part of the BMFA Centenary World record attempt. This was duplicated across the country, for as many model aircraft in the air at 12.00 o'clock, at one time. We had two flying areas to accommodate this task. The main field would be used for all types of fixed wing. The rotary area was used for drones, helicopters, and the odd paper plane and airship for good measure. Thank you for Mathew, Roy (and his air-horn), and Kevin for organising the day, as it ran without a hitch. We had over 30 aircraft in the air at 12.00. Also, special thanks to Ashok and Kaiyo who sort of volunteered to man the BBQ, their burgers were awesome and those present managed to eat at least a hundred of them with Ashok having the honour of the 100<sup>th</sup> one – see following photos.

Well, the good news is we helped smash the record. 263 BMFA affiliated clubs took part. The BMFA will now collate the information and this will be presented to the F.A.I. who will check/ ratify this before presenting it to The Guinness Book of Records etc. The grand total across the country was 3109 models in the air at the one time.
