

Safety Occurrence Report

The law: Various incidents during flight (only) - including any injury; high probability of serious injury or damage to full-size; any fly-away; any incident involving full size; any incident over 400'; or flight too close to uninvolved persons – must be reported by law to CAA/AAIB/BMFA. For any of these you can start the process at <https://reporting.bmfa.uk>

Please use this form to report incidents where an accident nearly occurred, or any situation you think could be dangerous – not just flying ones. These reports are only used to try to improve safety at the club. If issues are reported to the committee we can fix specific problems, and see patterns where a dangerous situation recurs.
