## P-51 Mustang saved from the Quarry

Phil Bartlet's Hangar 9 P-47 Mustang was lost in the quarry towards the end of last Summer after getting into an unrecoverable spin. Subsequent investigation indicated the most likely cause of the spin was a wing droop becoming dislodged in flight. The plastic droops, fitted to the leading edge of the wing, are part of Hangar 9's training system for this model which increase washout making it easier for a beginner to fly.

The plane was spotted a few weeks later by a member of the public, who kindly informed the club of it's whereabouts.

Phil promptly rescued the plane and after checking it over thoroughly, found to his amazement very little damage. The soft undergrowth had cushioned the landing and this, combined with Hangar 9's good quality construction meant the plane would fly again after being carefully dried out.

Phil handed the radio to Simon Hilson for an initial flight, without the wing droops fitted. The Mustang was easy to fly with good low speed handling which may make the droops unnecessary especially if the trainee is on a buddy-box. Very little re-trimming was required and the transmitter was quickly passed back to Phil to enjoy a few flights with his rescued plane. Hangar 9 certainly build them well!

## Eflite Extra 300 3D replacement airframe plan

One of the best indoor models has been the now unobtainable E-flite UMX Extra 3D.

These are excellent for indoor aerobatic and 3D flying but the 2mm depron airframe is fragile and easily damaged by collisions with walls or other aircraft!

Frank Dalby-Smith has made a replacement airframe for his Extra 300 using a patten he made from 2mm ply.

## Another chance to order WLMAC clothing

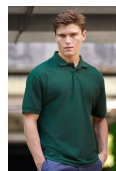
